- Physical Education (Kindergarten – 6th grade)
- Physical Education (7th – 12th grade)
- Physical Education (Kindergarten - 12th grade)

Program Definition

The physical education program is designed to prepare students to teach physical education in elementary and/or secondary schools. Physical Education majors will learn how to help students develop fundamental motor skills that lead to the promotion of healthy lifestyles and positive attitudes toward lifelong physical activity. In addition, physical educators commonly serve as coaches for interscholastic sports. Therefore, a coaching endorsement is also available and encouraged for all physical education majors.

A 20 hour introductory practicum and 80 hour practicum at the elementary and/or secondary level are required, allowing students to apply the strategies from their concurrent methods courses that they are completing. Student teaching is the culminating experience where the student demonstrates his/her knowledge and skills as a pre-service teacher. This supervised 16-week experience provides an opportunity to proactive teaching in a supportive and developmental setting. These individual programs can be completed in 4 years.

PSC Points of Distinction

- Teacher education programs at Peru State College are National Council for Accreditation (NCATE) accredited.
- Application of fitness and motor skill concepts to teaching.

- Peru State College has had a chapter of Kappa Delta Pi (The National Honor Society for Undergraduate Education Majors) for over seventy-five years. Members have opportunities to attend area and national conventions and to participate in a variety of activities involving public school students. Kappa Delta Pi also offers scholarships to its members.

- Students completing a degree at Peru State College are prepared to attend the nation's top graduate schools in all program areas. Many graduates return to Peru State for their masters degree, which can be completed online and in our accelerated format.

Program Expectations

1. Free from disciplinary probation.
2. Overall grade point average of at least 2.5
3. Minimum scores on the Pre Professional Skills Test (PPST) as follows: Reading 170, Math 171, Writing 172
4. Evidence of proficiency in English Composition and Mathematics as indicated by a grade of C or above in college level courses.
5. Reflect appropriate professional dispositions in an initial interview and throughout the program.
