Application for Non-Resident Working Full-Time in Nebraska

To Qualify: Employees or dependents of employees working full-time in Nebraska, who reside out-of-state but within states contiguous to Nebraska and file Nebraska non-resident income taxes may, at the discretion of the individual State Colleges, be charged in-state tuition rates.

Requirements: Students requesting resident tuition status under this policy will provide the institution with evidence of current full-time employment in the State of Nebraska and evidence of filing of Nebraska income tax forms for the most recent tax year. Eligibility for resident tuition under this policy is subject to review each term and will continue only as long as the required criteria are satisfied.

Last day to apply is general registration day. No exceptions. Applications must be in the Office of Admissions on the main campus by that date.
