PSC's Flex Meals are designed for commuters, faculty and staff members to dine in the cafeteria without the hassle of carrying cash – just bring your PSC ID card. Flex meals are a great way to stretch your food dollar and save time. It allows you to use your PSC ID card to make “cashless” purchases for food, drinks and snacks at the Bob Inn or the Student Dining Center.

## Sign Me Up!

To receive extra value, you can pre-deposit money in the following amounts:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Pre-deposit \$100 – we'll add an additional 10% to make it \$110.00.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Pre-deposit \$150 – we'll add an additional 15% to make it \$172.50.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Pre-deposit \$200 – we'll add an additional 20% to make it \$240.00.

## Additional Details

- Flex Meal balances can be carried over from fall to spring terms, but must be used by the end of the academic year or the cash value will be forfeited. **No refunds.**
- If a card is lost or stolen, you may purchase a new ID card from the Security Office and then contact Creative Dining; they will transfer your remaining balance to your new card.
- Want to know how much you have left? Balances are available through Dining Services and the Residence Life Office.
