

How to Start a Club

Only recognized student organizations may request to utilize College facilities and/or meet on College property. In order to form a recognized campus student organization, the following must be completed:

1. The organization must develop written guidelines and a constitution. Constitution guidelines can be found in the online forms bank or also by contacting Chelsea Allgood, Student Activities Coordinator @ (402) 872-2252 or email challgood@peru.edu.
2. The organization must have a full-time faculty or staff advisor. Advisor appointment forms can be found in the online forms bank or also by contacting Chelsea Allgood, Student Activities Coordinator @ (402) 872-2252 or email challgood@peru.edu.
3. The written constitution and the name of the faculty/staff advisor must be submitted to and approved by Student Senate.
4. Michaela Willis, Vice President of Enrollment Management and Student Affairs, must approve the advisor and constitution.
5. In no instance shall the constitution, guidelines or actions of the organization violate the College's discrimination policy.
6. All applicable College policies, Student Code of Conduct, local, state and federal laws must be adhered to by all students and student organizations.
