

Law Enforcement Tuition Waiver Application and Certificate of Verification

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The Law Enforcement Education Act provides to eligible law enforcement officers a waiver of thirty percent (30%) of tuition, after the subtracting all other awarded federal and state financial aid grants, and scholarships. Students seeking this waiver **must apply annually** and must comply with all College requirements for continued attendance. A student may receive the waiver for up to five (5) years if the student otherwise continues to be eligible for participation.

Instructions:

Any student requesting a law enforcement tuition waiver must:

- a. Complete and sign this application form;
- b. Have the student’s superior officer at the law enforcement agency at which the student is employed sign the certification at the end of this form attesting to the student’s satisfactory performance as a law enforcement officer; and
- c. Return the forms to Peru State College, One Stop, PO Box 10, Peru, NE 68421, no later than the class start date.
