Cats4Consent: Final Report

Mid-March, 2020, Peru State College moved all classes to remote delivery due to the Corona Virus Pandemic. The planning committee for April 2020 sexual assault awareness month, decided to adapt their original plans to digitally engage students, staff, and faculty.

Through Zoom, phone, and email, the planning committee created "Cats4Consent," a campaign to support Sexual Assault Awareness Month.

The campaign yielded tens of thousands of social media impressions, high social media engagement, and our campus' best donation drive of the year.

April 15-30: We shared messages of SAAM support though sidewalk art on campus. Students and staff posted the art they created on the sidewalks in front of their homes.


Posts were shared and retweeted on Twitter and Facebook with hashtags #Cats4Consent #SAAM #C4C.

Participants challenged each other to participate.


































Step 5 WALKIT-TALKIT






Step 7 WEAR DENIM For a Cause







